Classic French understatement. A really direct, pure style of Chablis, with a crystalline quality - fine and delicate.

Rose

Symposium Grenache Rosé

Vin de Pays de L'aude, France Medium 175ml: £5.75 Large 250ml: £6.75 £20.50

A delightfully soft and refreshing rose with just the right level of ripe redcurrant and summer fruit character.

Red Wine

Les Granges de Felines

Grenache. Merlot Vin de Pays des Coteaux de Peyriac.

Medium 175ml: £5.25 Large 250ml: £6.25 £15.00

Soft, easy country red from France. With an open texture hung with ripe red berry fruit, this unchallenging red from southern France has not compromised authenticity for its appeal.

Dry River

Shiraz, South Australia

Medium 175ml: £5.75 Large 250ml: £6.75 £17.00

Typically Australian, this bold Shiraz shows enticing black pepper and hints of spice gently cloaked in soft tannins.

Ochagavia Silvestre Merlot

Rapel, Chile

Mellow Merlot. A soft open and easy-drinking style showing vivid red fruits and a plummy softness.

Biferno Rosso Riserva 2011

Palladino

Wonderful authentic Southern Italian red. Ripe, juicy morello cherry fruit and a touch of spice. Full bodied, but with a softness from ageing in large barrels.

Don David Malbec

El Esteco, Argentina

£18.95

Steak's best friend. Dense and concentrated blackberry and plum fruit flavours with a savoury touch of dark chocolate, from this producer in Argentina's high altitude Salta region.

Rioja Crianza 2013

Marques de Arienzo

£19.50

Classic middleweight Rioja. Redcurrant fruit underpinned with gentle vanilla and coconut oak flavours.

Viña Leyda

Las Brisas Vineyard, Pinot Noir

£26.25

Super-succulent, hedonistic pinot noir from Chile. This delicious, slightly aromatic style of pinot noir has a silky texture and a depth of lifted, bright, red berry fruit that would be difficult to find in a red Burgundy at twice the price.

Château Bertinat Lartigue 2011

Saint-Émilion

£28.25

Classic Bordeaux. Firm, intense and full-bodied claret with ripe bramble and cassis fruit combined with a spicy autumn leaf character. This is a wine of textured class.

Crozes-Hermitage

Domaine les Chenêts

£29.00

Gentle giant from the Rhone. A judicious blend of classic Rhone grapes gives this a distinctive forest fruit compote character, with a touch of vanillato round it off. Full bodied, but with a wonderfully soft texture.
